


What happens during Larkwood Ward Reviews?


- Ward reviews are meetings where the staff that are supporting you talk about how you have been doing and the plan for your care that week.

The form has space for you to write about your views and opinions about your care.


Going out with staff for a while

The form has space to write about your views about your medications.




The form has space to write about your views on the coping skills you are learning.




The form has space to write about your views about your education.



The form has space to write about your goals for the week.






This is so the staff can learn what is important to you.
