













What happens during Larkwood Ward Reviews?

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- Ward reviews are meetings where the staff that are supporting you talk about how you have been doing and the plan for your care that week.
- Ward reviews happen every week.
- You get to have your say about what is important to you.
- This is so the staff know what you want and can help support you to achieve it.




	<p>The first part, called 'Part One', happens on Wednesdays.</p>
<p>multi-disciplinary team</p>  <p>MDT</p>	<p>Staff that work with you will be at the meeting.</p> <p>This might include the doctor, a nurse, a therapist, and a teacher.</p>
<p>prepare for meeting</p> 	<p>You can prepare for the meeting by filling in a form.</p>






<p>fill in form</p> 	<p>The form has space for you to write about your views and opinions about your care.</p>
<p>Going out with staff for a while</p> 	<p>The form has space to write about your views about your leave.</p> <p>'Leave' is going out of the hospital for a while.</p>
<p>Going out with parent/carer for a while</p> 	
<p>check on you</p> 	<p>The form has space to write about your views about your 'observation levels', which is how often the staff check on you.</p>

<p>Therapy session</p> 	<p>The form has space to write about your views about your therapy sessions.</p>
<p>my medication</p> 	<p>The form has space to write about your views about your medications.</p>
<p>relaxation</p> 	<p>The form has space to write about your views on the coping skills you are learning.</p>
<p>school</p> 	<p>The form has space to write about your views about your education.</p>
<p>achieve goals</p> 	<p>The form has space to write about your goals for the week.</p>

<p>comment compliment or complain</p> 	<p>There is also space to write your comments and questions.</p>
<p>ask questions</p> 	
<p>talk to team</p> 	<p>You will be asked to go into the room with the staff and talk about the things on your form with them.</p>
<p>10 minutes</p> 	<p>This takes about 10 to 15 minutes.</p>
<p>15 minutes</p> 	

<p>important to me</p> 	<p>This is so the staff can learn what is important to you.</p>
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	<p>Part two happens on Thursdays.</p>
<p>multi-disciplinary team</p>  <p>MDT</p>	<p>The staff team talk about how you have been over the week.</p>
<p>my care</p> 	<p>They talk about your care and what you said in your Part One review meeting.</p>

 <p>decision making</p>	<p>The staff team make decisions about your care.</p>
	<p>You will get written feedback about their decisions, so you know what the plan is.</p>
 <p>information from nurse</p>	<p>Someone will also talk to you about the decisions.</p>
	<p>Staff will call your parents or carers to let them know the decisions.</p>
	<p>Staff will tell your community support team about the plan by sending them an email.</p>
