
<u>What happens during Longview</u> <u>Ward Reviews?</u>

What happens during Longview Ward Reviews?

- Ward reviews are meetings where the staff that are supporting you talk about how you have been doing and the plan for your care that week.
- Ward reviews happen every week.
- You get to have your say about what is important to you.
- This is so the staff know what you want and can help support you to achieve it.





Therapy session	The form has space to write about your views about your therapy sessions
my medication	The form has space to write about your views about your medications.
good sometimes bad	The form has space to write about your views on the coping skills you are learning and how you are doing.
school	The form has space to write about your views about your education.
achieve goals	The form has space to write what you want, your goals for the week.

comment compliment or complain	There is also space to write your comments and questions.
talk to team	You will be asked to go into the room with the staff and talk about the things on your form with them.
10 minutes 10 minutes 10	This takes about 10 to 15 minutes.

important to me	This is so the staff can learn what is important to you.

	Part two happens on Wednesdays.
multi-disciplinary team ++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++	The staff team talk about how you have been over the week.
my care	They talk about your care and what you said in your Part One review meeting.

decision making	The staff team make decisions about your care.
	You will get written feedback about their decisions, so you know what the plan is.
information from nurse	Someone will also talk to you about the decisions.
Contraction of the second seco	Staff will call your parents or carers to let them know the decisions.
	Staff will tell your community support team about the plan by sending them an email.
