Oxevision is a Vision Based Patient Monitoring System (VBPMS) that supports staff to improve safety and to provide individualised, person-centred care to patients in inpatient mental health services.

Oxevision uses an infrared camera and illuminators which are linked to an interface at the nurse station in the form of a dedicated Oxevision fixed monitor and on portable tablets.

Oxevision will support your care by enabling staff to:

- Have location and activity-based alerts and warnings
- Ability to take cardio-respiratory vital signs (Pulse and breathing rate)
